

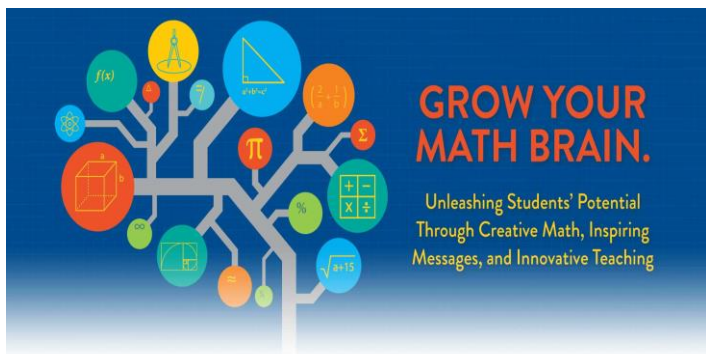

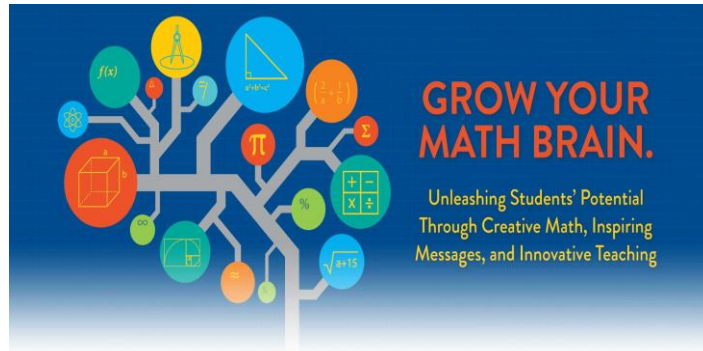

Creating Mathematical Mindsets: Changing the Culture of Maths for ALL students



The Curriculum and Instruction Department of the Ventura County of Education, in partnership with the California State University Channel Islands Department of Education, is offering a professional development program that focuses on creating Mathematical Mindsets for teachers and students of mathematics (maths). The program offers the opportunity for teachers grades 6-12 to be a part of a learning community that will:

- Develop a deeper understanding of what a Mathematical Mindset is, and why it is important for teachers and students
- Learn research-based classroom strategies to help students develop Mathematical Mindsets
- Experience low-floor/high-ceiling tasks that are essential to the development of Mathematical Mindsets
- Help transform beliefs about who is able to learn maths, and what it means to know and do maths

Participants Responsibilities:

- Full participation in the 3-day institute, June 12-14, 2017, and two follow-up days during the school year (dates to be determined by participants)
- A commitment to implement strategies and tasks to create Mathematical Mindsets in their classrooms

School or District Commitment:

- A \$50 registration fee and two days of release time for participation during the 2017-2018 school year
- A commitment to support the teacher in her/his efforts to create Mathematical Mindsets
