SUBJECT: School-Sponsored Trips

The Board recognizes that school-sponsored trips are important components of a student's development. Besides supplementing and enriching classroom learning experiences, such trips encourage new interests among students, make them more aware of community resources, and help them relate their school experiences to the outside world.

The Superintendent shall develop and implement procedures governing school-sponsored trips in the schools and programs which are governed by the Superintendent (i.e., Community Schools, ROP, and where applicable, Juvenile Court Schools and Special Education).
