SUBJECT: Nondiscrimination - Students

County programs and activities shall be free from discrimination with respect to gender, race, color, religion, national origin, ethnic group, marital or parental status, physical or mental disability, and actual or perceived sexual orientation.

The Superintendent shall ensure equal opportunities for all students in admission and access to academic courses, guidance and counseling programs, athletic programs, testing procedures, vocational education and other activities.

Separate gender arrangements may be made for students according to gender in order to protect modesty in shower rooms and family life instruction, to adjust grading standards in physical education and athletic competition.

All staff and volunteers must be especially careful to guard against non-conscious gender discrimination and stereotyping in instruction, guidance and supervision.
