SUBJECT: Real Property

The Ventura County Board of Education is authorized by law to acquire, lease, lease-purchase, hold and convey real property for the purpose of housing the offices and services of the Office and the Superintendent, and to exercise the power of eminent domain when necessary in performing this function. Agreements for real property acquisitions for this purpose must be approved by the Board.

Subsequent to Board approval, responsibility for the disposition, usage, improvement and operation of real property shall accrue to the County Superintendent of Schools or authorized designee for the purpose of allocating facility resources in the most effective and efficient manner in the furtherance of student and staff educational goals and objectives.

These efforts shall include both long and short-term planning, design, reconfiguration, modernization, construction and management of all facilities as well as interfacing with State and local agencies, identification and pursuit of funding mechanisms, fiscal management of projects, hiring of consultants, and other related activities.
