


Interested in becoming a teacher?



CLASSIFIED SCHOOL EMPLOYEE PROGRAM (CSEP)

The Ventura County Office of Education is currently accepting applications for the California Classified School Employee Program (CSEP).

CSEP is a state-funded career pathway program for classified employees, leading to a teacher preparation program and teaching credential.

Eligible participants may receive stipends for up to \$3,000 to cover tuition, testing fees, and books.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a current classified employee at a Ventura County school district and,
- have completed at least 48 college level units.

PARTICIPANTS MUST COMMIT TO ACCOMPLISH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Obtain a multiple subject, single subject, or education specialist teaching credential.
- Complete a school year of classroom instruction for each year of financial assistance received.
