Title IV, Part A, Subpart 1 funds are apportioned to eligible local educational agencies (LEAs) to increase the capacity to meet the goals of the ESEA by providing all students with access to well-rounded education, improving school conditions for student learning, and improving use of technology in order to improve the academic and digital literacy of all students.
