SUBJECT: Courses of Study

The Board shall adopt a course of instruction for students in County-operated programs which sufficiently prepares them for the required high school course of study specified in state law. The adopted course of instruction shall be reviewed by the Board at least every two years. The course of study shall conform to the county graduation requirements and the requirements for admission to California public universities. Courses of study shall provide students the opportunity to attain skills appropriate for entry-level employment in business and industry upon graduation from high school.
