

**VENTURA COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF
FEBRUARY 07, 2022**

A. CALL TO ORDER

1. Call to Order, Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag, and Moment of Reflection
The Regular Meeting of the Ventura County Board of Education, Agenda 22-04, was called to order by Rachel Ulrich, Board President at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, February 7, 2022, in the Board Room of the VCOE Conference & Educational Services Center, 5100 Adolfo Road, Camarillo. Dr. Lisagor moved the agenda be approved. Mr. Teasdale seconded the motion and the motion carried upon a unanimous vote (4:0). (Dr. Flores arrived at 6:08 p.m.)

Mr. Teasdale made a motion to reverse the decision of the Oxnard Union High School District. Dr. Flores seconded the motion.

After careful deliberations, the Ventura County Board of Education took action to reverse the appeal for expulsion cases 2201E and 2202E from the Oxnard Union High School District. The Board voted unanimously (5:0) in this matter.

Dr. Morales said this concludes this process and told the parents they will receive a letter within 72 hours confirming this decision.

Ms. Ulrich hopes the family works with the district to help these students move forward. She also stated appreciation to the district and understands the difficulty of this case and their efforts in ensuring the safety of all students.


E. ADJOURNMENT
