SUBJECT: Board to Board Dialogues

It is the policy of the County Board to promote ongoing, interactive dialogues between school district boards of education and members of the County Board of Education. The Board believes that such dialogues between Board members will provide models for improved communication, thereby strengthening the relationships between the County Office of Education and the school districts which it serves.

To that end, the County Board shall periodically co-sponsor or organize at least one formal dialogue between local district boards and the County Board. This dialogue, structured as a forum to allow participation by attendees, shall focus upon an issue or issues of county office and school district interaction. The Board President shall be responsible for ensuring that this formal dialogue takes place.

It is the Board's hope that this annual dialogue will help to foster collaboration among the governing boards and will lead to a number of informal, less structured interactions between board members throughout the year.
